QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT

1. Transportation of coal from mine end to railway siding & loading in Indian Railway wagons for onward transportation to NSPCL-Bhilai.

Technical Criteria:

- The bidder should have executed work of Loading, Transportation by road and unloading of coal or any other mineral as per the following criteria:
- 1.1 The bidder must have carried out above work and loading of coal or any other mineral into rakes for a quantity of at least 50,000.00 MT of coal or any other mineral in any one month and at least 1.5 lakh MT in any continuous three months in last 7 years as on the date of techno commercial bid opening against single order or multiple orders.

Notes for technical criteria:

- a) The word "Executed" mentioned in clause 1 means that the Bidder should have achieved the specified criteria with any of the following conditions;
- i) The work/order is started earlier (prior to the period mentioned in clause 1.1), but completed within the stipulated period. In such cases, entire executed quantity/value of the relevant work vide that work order shall be considered for evaluation.
- ii) The work/order is started and completed within the stipulated period as mentioned in the clause 1.1. In such cases, entire executed quantity/value of the relevant work vide that work order shall be considered for evaluation.
- iii) The work/order is started within the stipulated period as mentioned in the clause 1.1 but not completed as on the last date of stipulated period. In such cases, "in progress" executed quantity/value of the relevant work certified by the owner vide that work order as on the last date of the stipulated period shall be considered for evaluation.
- b) Reference work executed by the bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided the certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by Project Authority specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirement.

Financial Criteria

2. The average annual turnover of the Bidder in the preceding three (03) financial years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening **shall not be less than Rs. 436.95 lakhs.**

Notes for Financial Criteria:

- While computing the annual turnover other income shall not be considered.
- ◆ In case where audited results for the last preceding financial year as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO/Proprietor/Partners as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

NIT Conditions

- Bid documents will be issued to all the parties on their request (cost of tender document to be made by a crossed demand draft / pay order / banker's cheque in favour of NTPC SAIL POWER COMPANY LIMITED payable at Bhilai) for issue of bid documents without prima-facie examination of their qualification status. However, issue of bid documents shall not mean that bidders are considered qualified. Tender document fee will not be refunded. Request for tender documents received after the last date as mentioned above due to delays postal/courier services shall not be entertained.
- 2. Complete set of bidding documents are also available on NTPC website www.ntpctender.com prospective bidders can down load the same for submission of bids after tendering the cost of bidding documents directly on the website.
- 3. NSPCL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 4. Agencies are advised to visit the site to familiarize themselves with the nature of work and the site conditions.
- 5. Small-scale industries registered with NSIC/MSME shall be exempted for payment of EMD & Tender Fee. (Subject to submission of copy of registration giving details, such as validity, monetary limit, etc.)
- 6. If the last date of receiving application and date of bid opening coincide with a holiday, the date will be shifted to the next working day.
