# Instruction for e-bidding:

- 1. The bidder must have Digital Signature Certificate (Class-III).
- **2.** The bidders who already have valid SRM User ID:
- a) Login the SRM Portal and click on RFX and Auction button.
- b) Rfx will be available to view for all the bidders which are already having valid SRM User ID's.
- c) Interested bidders have to register first against the Bid invitation by clicking on "Register" button placed into Rfx header segment.
- d) Tender document fee should be submitted on line/offline (Demand Draft / Pay Order / Banker's Cheque) only except exemption document also may be submitted online/offline.
- e) Once Registration step & Tender fee submission is done by bidder and the tender fee received by the NSPCL and updated into the system then Bidder could be able to "Create Response" and submit the bids against the Bid invitation into the system.
- 3. New Bidders which are not having SAP/ERP Vendor Code and or SRM User ID:
- a) In case a new bidder wants to participate for a particular Bid invitation in SRM portal, the bidder first of all has to submit the filled Registration Form & NEFT Form along with required supporting documents e.g. as specified in forms, till 06/03/2023 to C&M department, NSPCL Bhilai in hard copy or scanned copy through e-mail at: preeti.yadu@nspcl.co.in, bn.goutam@nspcl.co.in
- b) C&M department will initiate the process for vendor ID creation in SAP & send the bidders SRM Credentials (User ID along with initial Password)
- c) After creation of SRM Credentials the step 2 (above) shall be followed by the bidder.

## **QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:**

#### 1.0 Technical Requirement:

1.1 The bidder should have carried out design or engineering, manufacturing, supply, erection or supervision of erection and commissioning or supervision of commissioning of at least one no. Cast Resin Dry Type Transformer of rating 630kVA and above, during last Seven years as on the date of technical bid opening.

Copies of following documents should be submitted by the bidder in support of the above stipulated requirements:

- Work order or contract document or purchase order.
- Commissioning certificate or performance certificate or completion certificate or final acceptance certificate.
- 1.2 In case the bidder is a consortium of two or more parties as members, the experience of the concerned member should be commensurate with the responsibility matrix provided in the consortium agreement.

Copies of following documents should be submitted in support of the above showing experience as per the responsibility matrix for each member of the consortium, as applicable:

- Memorandum of agreement with responsibility matrix of members
- Work order or contract document or purchase order.
- Commissioning certificate or performance certificate or completion certificate or final acceptance certificate.
- 1.3 The bidder should have executed **Similar Work(s)** during the preceding 7 (Seven) years reckoned as on the date of technical bid opening having:
  - a) Executed value not less than Rs. 136.88 lakhs in a Single Order

OR

b) Executed value not less than Rs. 85.55 lakhs in two Orders each

OR

c) Executed value not less than Rs. 68.44 lakhs in three Orders each

## 2.0 Financial Requirement:

**2.1** The average annual turnover of the Bidder in the preceding three (3) financial years as on the date of technical bid opening should not be less than **Rs 85.55 lakhs** (Indian Rupees Eighty-Five Lakh and Fifty-Five Thousand Only). Assessed as per clause 4.1 of Purchase Management System Manual IV edition Annexure 5.

#### Notes:

- i) Values as per clause 1.3 and 2.1 shall be considered inclusive of taxes & duties.
- ii) The word "Executed" means the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in Qualifying Requirements, even if the total contract is not completed/closed. A work executed in the preceding seven (7) years reckoned as on the date of technical bid opening, even if it has been started earlier, will also be considered for meeting the requirement against Clause 1.4 above. Agency has to furnish proof of executed value of the work in the form of copies of RA Bills, Relevant PO copy and client's completion certificate/RA bill/Final Deviation Statement etc. in support of meeting Qualifying Requirement.
- iii) The phrase "Similar Work(s) means work defined at clause 1.1 of Technical Requirement.
- iv) In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Technical Bid Opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from a practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO/Proprietor/Partner as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Technical bid opening and the Certificate from the practising Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.
- V) Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

### **NIT Conditions**

- 1. - 2. NSPCL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 3. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any bidder shall not construe that bidder is considered qualified.
- 4. Agencies are advised to visit the site to familiarize themselves with the nature of work and the site conditions.
- 5. Small-scale industries registered with UDYAM shall be exempted for payment of Tender Fee. (Subject to submission of copy of registration giving details, such as validity, monetary limit, etc.)
- 6. NSPCL shall allow purchase preference, as indicated in the bidding documents, to bids from local suppliers as defined in the bidding documents. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to undertake a physical assessment of the capacity and capabilities including financial capacity and capability of the Bidder / his Collaborator(s) /Associate(s) / Subsidiary(ies) / Group Company(ies) to perform the Contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.

The physical assessment shall include but not be limited to the assessment of the office/facilities/banker's/reference works by the Employer. A negative determination of such assessment of capacity and capabilities may result in the rejection of the Bid.

The above right to undertake the physical assessment shall be applicable for the qualifying requirements stipulated above.

8. If the last date of receiving application and date of bid opening coincide with a holiday, the date will be shifted to the next working day.
